Armband Numbers and Check-In: Armbands will be available at the check-in table (alphabetical by handler).

Check-in for measuring: Begins both days at 7:15 a.m. Additional measuring time will be provided (as available) as courses are being set. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. **Reminder:** All exhibitors should carry their dog's original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card upon request.

We will have a **Measuring Official**. If you do not have a permanent height card, your dog MUST be measured for one.

Move ups for the July 31 trial must be received by 6 p.m. on Monday, July 26. Day-to-day move ups will be allowed between trial days and must be submitted in person to the trial secretary within ½ hour of the end of judging on Saturday.

Paved parking is located close to the building. Additional parking is available at the new office building on the left. Please do NOT block the driveway. Due to space limitations, **RVs** that do not fit completely within the confines of a regular 7 x 18 parking space are strictly prohibited. **No ex-pens** in the parking area. There is no overnight parking at the show site.

Food and refreshments will be available at the trial site.

Crating/setup:

- ◆ The building will be available for set-up on Friday evening after 7:00 p.m. AND all equipment has been unloaded.
- ◆ WATERPROOF cloth or tarps MUST be placed underneath crates.

Directions to Carroll Indoor Sports Center:

From **Baltimore:** From Baltimore Beltway (I-695) take Exit 19, Northwest Expressway (I-795) towards Owings Mills/Reisterstown. Continue until the Expressway ends, bear right onto Route 140 West. Follow 140 West for approx. 10 miles, turn left onto Route 97 (Weis Market on right, PetSmart market on the left.) At the 2nd light, turn Left onto Old Westminster Pike. The Carroll Indoor Sports Center will be on the right a short distance after the turn.

From **DC & Virginia:** From DC Beltway (I-495) take I-270 exit towards Frederick. From 270, take Damascus exit (Route 27 North). Stay on 27 North approx. 25 miles to Main Street in Westminster. Turn right onto Main Street. Go 1.5 miles. C.I.S.C. will be on right side of road after crossing over Route 97.
