Bred by Judy Gooding, her sire was Dewey, CH Lost River Tri'd NTru Irish Mist, co-owned and bred by Shawn Michael and Kathy Hash, and her dam, Terenelf Schweet P'Tater, Tatum, was bred by the late Lois Kay.

We visited Judy on that day with hopes of purchasing a bitch to show and breed and quickly determined Eve would be a good candidate, but we like to think she chose us as much as we chose her. When George climbed into the ex-pen to visit with the five puppies all of them quickly lost interest while Eve curled up next to him in the shade and went to sleep. We brought her home a few weeks later.

Eve's temperament was delicious, as was the temperament of both Dewey and Tatum. She was affectionate and liked to be near people. When I was at home working, she would sit on a bed that I had set up in my office. She did NOT like being left alone. She not only was a wonderful pet and companion from the day we brought her home but eventually became an AKC Champion. While I handled her some, she earned the majority of her points with Ferebe Simons, who always reported that she did not like to be by herself and especially liked hanging out with her father while he worked in his shop.

Eve loved lure coursing and quickly earned her CA title at the Fun Fair events and eventually added Rally Advanced, CGCA, and TKN titles to her name. She would have loved Fast CAT if that event had been available when she was younger, but by far her greatest accomplishments are two wonderful litters. She was an attentive and affectionate mama. Through her pups we became friends with three families who joined and became active in PWCCP. Pups Sera, Caleb, Lewie, and Nicki earned multiple titles in Rally, Obedience, Fast CAT, Trick Dog, CGC, and Scent Work.



Eve became a great corgi ambassador while vacationing at my sister Janet's cabin in Maine. During the summer she loved going on our morning three-mile walks and hanging out by the lake, and she enjoyed winter visits when she plays in the snow. She made many friends during these stays and was especially fond of Janet, whom we routinely visit for Friday night family dinners. She recognized the pattern of our Friday afternoons and became visibly excited as we got ready to leave.

The last year or so, Eve was down in back. We helped her to go outside with the help of a sling and would take her about in the neighborhood in a little wagon. She loved those walks! She would look out and smile and enjoy the scenery.

We said goodbye to Eve on December 4, 2024. Until the last couple of weeks, she still had that sparkle in her eyes. It was a heartbreaking loss; she was part of our household for so many years. We will never forget our funny, sweet girl and we are grateful to have had her for so many wonderful years.

Thanks for the memories, Eve. You will be always in our hearts.

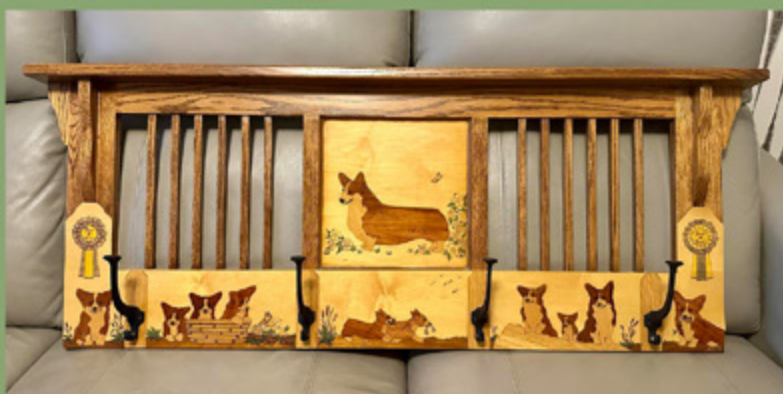

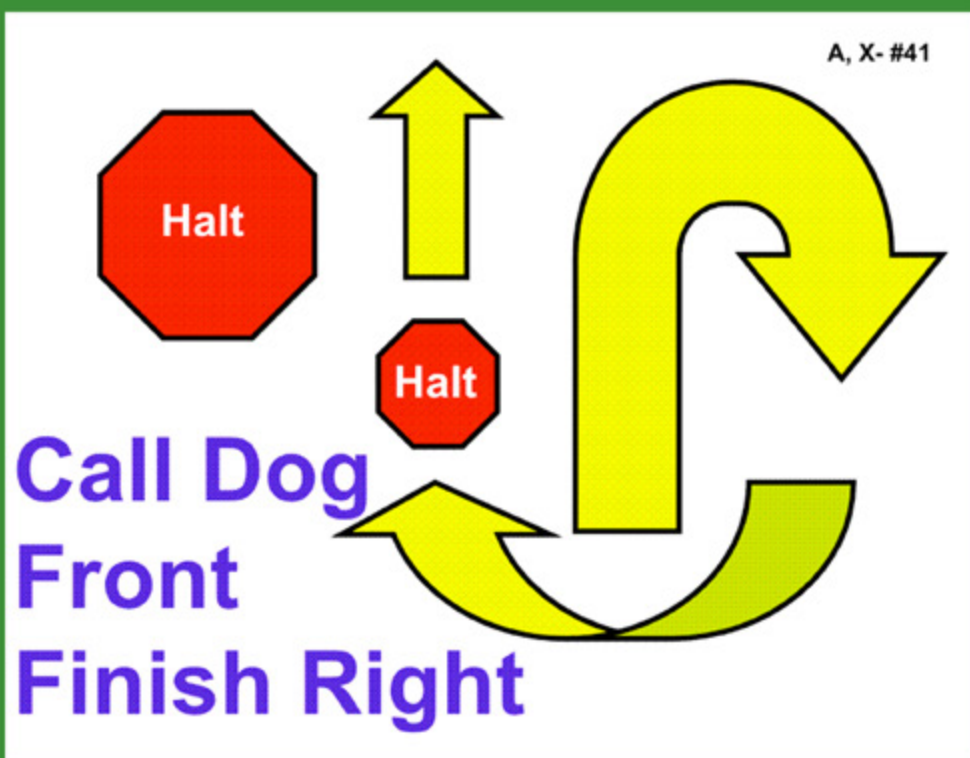

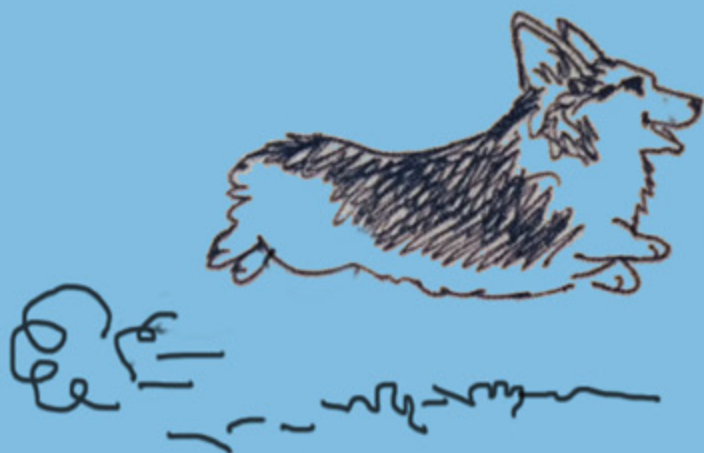

ADVERTISING IN THE TIDE

Advertising in The Tide is limited to PWCCP members and PWCCA-affiliate club members. Advertising rates for non-PWCCP members (unless invited to advertise because of a PWCCP specialty or match win) and commercial businesses are double the PWCCP member rates and are subject to approval by the editor. Advertising on the front cover or on page two is available by invitation from the editor.

Please review the following guidelines so that all the information that you wish to include is provided to us. This will prevent us from having to request additional information and will help to avoid confusion by having everything submitted at the same time.

Any or all of the following items may be submitted:

- Registered and call name of the dog.
- Sire and dam. It is generally a good idea to include the sire and dam for conformation Corgis. Sire and dam may be included for performance dogs. Rescue Corgis in performance under the AKC PALS program would not have a breed history, so would not have this included.
- What was achieved? What accomplishment(s) are you advertising?
- Where was it achieved (location and show)?
- Under which judge?
- On what date?
- Breeder (may be acknowledged formally or with such phrases as heartfelt thanks, etc.)
- Handler (including owner/handler and in the case of a handler not the owner may include thank yous).
- Owner (in the case of a particularly crowded ad, where the owner/handler is pictured, this can be noted in the picture).
- Photos: You must supply the name of the photographer or studio, even if you took the pictures yourself. It is the policy of The Tide to give attribution on all photos. Attribution is a legal requirement for professional photos. If there are special circumstances where the photographer is not known, please discuss with the Advertising Editor, or with the Editor.
- People in the photos: Judge and professional handler may be identified out of courtesy and as helpful information. Owner/handler is optional if ad is submitted by the owner/handler.
- Kennel logos are a good idea and may be included.
- Phone numbers, addresses, and email of breeders can be included by the breeder or with permission of the breeder if they are the advertiser, a member or if they co-own the dog with the advertiser. Publication of non-club members' names, addresses, and phone numbers may be listed in the Tide for those who co-own dogs with the advertiser.
- Finally, include any special text or explanations. (Please note that space is limited, and a long text will result in much smaller pictures, etc.)
